## Congrats Recode Therapeutics!

ReCode Therapeutics has closed a \$120 million extension to a series B funding round to bring their research to human trials. ReCode is a platform company based on lipid nanoparticle technology that targets organs such as the lungs and liver. With the new funding, ReCode plans to file an FDA request to bring its two lead programs—one targeting primary ciliary dyskinesia, the other focusing on cystic fibrosis—to human trials.
